cooked food leftovers  
meat, bones  
vacuum cleaner bags  
sweepings  
dirty paper  
sanitary products  
nappies  
sanitary towels  
tampons  
small animal litter (mineral)  
cigarette butts  
charcoal  
foil from renovations  
wallpaper residue  
light bulbs  
cigarette lighters  
markers  
transparent sleeves

### Not for:

contaminated waste  
electrical appliances  
rubble  
energy-saving and  
fluorescent lamps



## Yellow bin



### For empty packaging only!

#### Plastic packages:

pots for margarine,  
milk products, etc.

Plastic bottles/pouches for:  
toiletries, detergent, washing agents

#### Metal packages:

aluminium foil, foil lids and trays,  
tin cans, glass and bottle closures

#### Beverage cartons:

milk and juice packages

### Not for:

paper and glass  
residual waste  
all non-package waste  
e.g. toys, small appliances  
nappies

## Organic waste bin



### For organic waste only!

#### From the kitchen:

eggshells, vegetable,  
fruit and salad refuse,  
coffee grounds/filters,  
nutshells, fruit stones,  
raw food leftovers,  
citrus fruits, teabags

#### From the garden:

flowers, potting soil,  
windfall, leaves, moss,  
lawn cuttings, hedge trimmings,  
weeds

### Not for:

plastic bags, biopolymers,  
cooked food leftovers  
meat, bones  
liquids  
vacuum cleaner bags  
sweepings  
ashes, cigarette butts  
small animal litter (mineral)  
nappies

## Cardboard/Paper



### Crush beforehand!

Packages made of  
paper/cardboard, e.g.  
breakfast cereal or  
detergent boxes

envelopes,  
books (without plastic covers),  
booklets, catalogues,  
(crushed) cartons,  
wrapping paper,  
(clean) paper bags,  
brochures, writing paper,  
newspapers, magazines

### Not for:

dirty or coated paper  
beverage and milk cartons  
tissues  
wallpaper

## Glass



### Sorted according to white, green and brown glass

only for bottle bank glass e.g.  
non-returnable bottles,  
preserve jars

#### REMEMBER:

→ blue bottles count as  
green glass.  
→ please place lids inside the  
bottle bank.

### Not for:

sheet glass  
(e.g. windows, mirrors)  
ceramics  
porcelain  
light bulbs  
energy-saving lamps  
fluorescent tubes  
optical/borosilicate glass  
returnable bottles
